Age: 38 years as on the 1st January 2019 with relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST/PWD and 3 years for OBC/MOBC candidates.

Qualifications:

1. Good Academic Record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale whenever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
3. Candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree Regulation) 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

4. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
5. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for SC/ST/Differently-abled (both physically and visually) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching position. The eligibility marks of 50% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale whenever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark.
6. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. holders who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991.
7. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience for appointment to the position.
8. Reference date for acquiring qualification- candidate has to acquire qualifications as on the last date for submitting applications. Eligibility like M.Phil./Ph.D./Seminar Papers/Publications can be acquired and submitted on the date of interview but not beyond.
9. In-service candidates must apply through proper channel with NOC obtained from the concerned authority.
10. Educational qualifications and selection procedure will be as per Govt. Office Memorandum No. AHE.407/2017/44, dated 08-11-2018.
