J B College : Glorious Past and Promising Future

Jagannath Barooah College, since its inception in 1930, has marched a long way as one of the premier institutes of higher education. Having traversed a journey of glorious 84 years, Jagannath Barooah College has carved a niche for itself not only in the 'Cultural Capital' Jorhat but through the entire North-East. Reaccredited by NAAC with 'A' grade and selected by UGC as "College with Potential for Excellence", the College celebrated its Platinum Jubilee in the year 2005. Confident of its present and hopeful of its future, Jagannath Barooah College takes pride in having moulded many citizens of high repute, established in different fields like science, literature, teaching, administration, music, culture etc.

Behind the establishment of this premier seat of higher education lies the selfless and enthusiastic commitment of a small but highly learned group of scholars of this culturally rich city who, in fact, shaped the destiny of the academic milieu of the North East region in general and the entire Brahmaputra valley in particular. The valuable contributions made by this dedicated group subsequently led to the formal initiation of an institution known as **Upper Assam College** in Jorhat in 19th August, 1930. Less than a month later, i.e., on 4th September 1930, the first Governing Body (GB) Meeting of the Upper Assam College resolved to name the college as **Jorhat College** and this continued till 1938 when, in a resolution of another GB Meeting, it was again decided to rename the college as **Jagannath Barooah College**. The founder Principal of this oldest institution of the region was Prof. Krishna Kanta Handiqui, world renowned Orientalist, distinguished scholar and academician. The other dedicated founder teachers were Prof. Tulsi Narayan Sarma (Founder Secretary), Jagneswar Sarma, Phanidhar Dutta, Prafulla Pran Changkakati and Gunagobinda Dutta. With a

small batch of 14 students in 1930, the college began its journey with Intermediate of Arts (IA) which received formal affiliation from Calcutta University in 1931. Thereafter, the progress of the college was rapid. In 1939, the Intermediate of Commerce (I.Com.), in 1941 the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in 1944 the Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com), in 1949-50 the Intermediate of Science I.Sc.) and in 1952-53 the Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) streams were opened. From 1931 to 1948, the college was affiliated to Calcutta University and from 1948 to 1965 to Gauhati University. Since the establishment of Dibrugarh University (DU) in 1965, the college has been affiliated to it. The college now has a diversified field of teaching. Currently it has 20 departments, viz., **Assamese, Bengali, Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, Economics, English, Geography, Geology, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physics and Electronics, Political Science, Sanskrit, Statistics and Zoology.** Since 2013 J.B. College has been imparting Major programmes only. Except **Bengali, Biotechnology** and **Computer Science**, all other subjects have **Major Courses** at the Degree level. Since its inception, J.B. College has always engaged itself in its search of academic excellence with the motto "**Na, hi Jnanena Sadrisam Pavitramiha Vidyate**" i.e. 'there is nothing holier than knowledge'.

Equipped with tools like "College with Potential for Excellence" and Grade 'A' awarded by NAAC, Jagannath Barooah College is heading towards autonomy. An autonomous status for the institution is already in the pipeline as the College is awaiting the visit of an expert team from UGC for inspection towards the end of June, 2015. Standing on the threshold of autonomy, the Jagannath Barooah College family is confident that a status of autonomy is definitely going to provide a conducive environment for the all round development of the college.

RULES FOR TRANSFER FROM OTHER UNIVERSITY/OTHER COLLEGES UNDER DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY :

Transfer from other Universities to Dibrugarh University shall be permissible provided that -

- (i) Both the Universities conduct the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com degree programmes in the semester system,
- (ii) The course structure along with the nomenclature of the courses are similar between the two Universities,
- (iii) The combination of courses opted by the candidate are not changed.

Ordinarily, the University shall not allow inter-college transfer.

- (i) No change in course combination shall be allowed with transfer from one college/institute to other.
- (ii) A candidate shall have to apply for transfer in the prescribed format of the University.
- (iii) A candidate may be allowed for college transfer only once during the whole programme.

AMENDMENTS IN DU REGULATIONS :

As recommended by the 104th meeting of the Academic Council held on 09.06.2015, the 323rd meeting of the Executive Council held on 10.06.2014 vide Resolution No. 50 has approved the following amendments in the Dibrugarh University Regulations for the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Programmes in the Semester System, 2010 :

Clauses : 11(a)

Amended as :

A candidate shall be declared as passed a course, provided he/she secured -

(i) at least 30% marks in each course in the end semester examination.

(ii) atleast 30% marks in each course in aggregate and in the end semester examination.

Clauses : 11(b)

Amended as :

The degrees shall be offered to each candidate, who has passed the Six Semester Degree B.A./B.Sc./B.Com programme in the following manner :

General (Non-Major) Programme

marks in aggregate.

k) **A student must pass all his/her semester examinations within FIVE (5) years from the date of admission to the First Semester of any programme.**

l) Since the Semester System involves continuous assessment, there shall be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any programme in this system.

Rules for Internal Assessment in BA/B.Sc./B.Com. Programmes in Semester System :

The marks allotted for Internal Assessment (20%) in each course shall be based on the following :

- a) **Sessional Examination I (Written)** - 25% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.
- b) **Sessional Examination II (Written)** - 25% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.
- c) **Seminar/Group Discussion/Home Assignment** - 25% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.
- d) **Attendance** - 25% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.

* The marks of internal assessment secured by a candidate shall be carried over to next legitimate chances.

* **If any student fails to appear in internal assessment he/she shall not be eligible to appear in the end-semester examinations of the course(s) concerned. The college/institutes shall notify the same.**

* If a course is taught by more than one teacher then the concerned teachers shall conduct the process of internal assessment jointly. It would be a part of his/her normal duty.

- c) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation of the answer scripts of the end-semester examinations. However, a candidate may apply for re-scrutiny.
- d) A student who has less than 80% attendance (in theory and practical as applicable) shall not be permitted to sit for the end-semester examination in the course in which the shortfall exists.
- e) There shall be one End Semester examination carrying 80% Marks in each course of a semester covering the entire syllabus prescribed for the course.
- f) Setting of question papers, moderation of question papers, evaluation of answer scripts, scrutiny, tabulation of marks etc. and announcement of results shall be governed by the Dibrugarh University Examination Ordinance, 1972 (as amended upto date)
- g) Practical Examination of a Semester shall normally be held prior to the End Semester Examinations. **No betterment shall be allowed in the Practical Examinations.**
- h) A candidate shall be declared passed a semester provided he/she passes all the courses of a semester independently.
- i) **A candidate shall be entitled to a maximum of three chances to clear a course.**
- j) If a candidate clears the sixth semester examination before clearing all the courses of the previous semesters, the result of the sixth semester examination of that candidate shall be withheld till he/she clears the courses of the previous semesters.

Structure of Courses of the Programmes :

All B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Programmes shall have the following components :

- i) **Compulsory Courses** : These courses are the compulsory courses for all students of the programme concerned.
- ii) **Major Courses** : Major courses shall be optional and non-mandatory. Major courses shall be chosen by the students.
- iii) **Non-Major Courses** : Non-Major courses shall be chosen by the students who do not opt for Major courses.
- iv) **Skill-based Courses** : A skill-based course shall be mandatory for all students pursuing GENERAL BA and B.Sc. programme.

Examination and Evaluation :

- a) Examination and Evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis, at least three times during each semester.
- b) There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End-Semester examination in each course during every semester.

B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. SEMSTER COURSE
(SEMESTER SYSTEM UNDER DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY)
Academic Session : 2015 - 2016

Semester System is an innovative approach to teaching-learning process, an educational culture, a student-friendly system, which require a new mindset in the part of the learners as well as the facilitators of learning.

The UGC vide its circular No. D.O. No. F.I-2/2008 dated March 2009 under the new initiatives for academic reforms under XI plan that the Universities shall have to take necessary action in order to introduce the Semester System at the under graduate level by 2012.

As recommended by the 103 Meeting of the Under Graduate Board, Dibrugarh University held on 19.08.2010, the 95 Meeting of the Academic Council, Dibrugarh University held on 09.09.2010, vide Resolution No. 9 has approved the Dibrugarh University Regulation for BA/B.Sc./B.Com Programmes in the Semester System, 2010. This has come into effect from **2011-2012 Academic Session**. The Semester Programme is of three years duration distributed in six semesters.

- * **1st, 3rd and 5th Semesters : ODD SEMESTER**
June 15 - Nov. 30
- * **2nd, 4th and 6th Semesters : EVEN SEMESTER**
Jan. 01 - June 30

Admission Notice and Criteria :

Newspaper Notice inviting applications for admission into the different programmes shall be issued by the Principals

GENERAL RULES

1. A student shall lose his/her right of Admission to his/her class, if he/she fails to attend his/her classes continuously for 15 teaching days from the date of the commencement of classes.
2. The courses of study in J. B. College are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course concurrently. If any student is admitted to any other course, then the student/guardian should inform the college authority immediately and discontinue the other course if he/she wants to continue the course at J.B. College. Violation of this provision will lead to disciplinary action.
3. **If a newly admitted student of HS or TDC First Semester fails to attend classes within 07 (Seven) days from the commencement of classes, he/she will forfeit his/her seat.**
4. Students are responsible for their conduct to the Principal and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the college, that amounts to breach of discipline or interference in the discipline and normal working of the college. Students shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules of discipline. Disciplinary action may involve warning and/or fine, and/or suspension from classes, from the examination, from the use of the college library or even from the college as such.

5. Students shall conduct themselves in decorous manner both towards the members of the staff (Teaching and Administrative) and towards their fellow students. Insubordination, unbecoming language or indecorous conduct including teasing, ragging, assaulting others, etc. shall be severely dealt with.
5. Students shall maintain perfect silence in the classroom and desist from demonstration or disorderly behaviour. They must not loiter in the corridor or in front of the classroom and must keep as quiet as possible at all times.
7. Students shall take proper care of the college property, furniture and premises and they must not spoil or cause any damage to, or tamper with the college property, furniture and fittings. They shall not litter the college campus.
8. Students shall leave their bicycles, scooters/motorcycles locked in the shed provided for this purpose. No two-wheelers should be parked in any other part of the college campus.
9. No Society can be formed in the college without the permission of the Principal, nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the college without the prior permission of the college authority.
10. Students shall not bring in to college campus any article deemed by the college authority to have a dangerous and /or disruptive influence on the academic environment. Use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited inside the college campus. Students who fail to switch off their Cell phones inside the class will have to pay a fine of Rs.500/- (Rupees five

hundred only). Students found in possession of Cell phones inside the examination hall are liable to be expelled.

11. All students will be required to attend classes and other activities held inside the college campus in College **UNIFORM**.

Leave Rules : For B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.Semester Programme

1. 7% per Semester leave for participation in NCC Camps, Debates, Quiz, Sports, Cultural Programmes, etc. will be granted as per College Guidelines. Prior intimation for leave for such activities will have to be submitted to the Vice Principal.
2. Members of College Team participating in the Inter-College Competitions will be granted 10% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required attendance of 80%.
3. Members of the J. B. College Students' Union will be granted 10% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required 80% due to their engagements in Union related activities.
4. Students will be granted 12% attendance on medical ground. Students applying for medical leave will have to submit a medical certificate issued by a Govt. Doctor along with the application. **The Application must be addressed to the Principal and submitted to the Vice Principal within a week of his/her rejoining his/her class.**
